

FAQs for Allerton Family Campout and Exploration

- 1. May I bring a trailer or other type of wheeled/axled sleeper to the campout?**
Unfortunately, personal vehicles are not allowed in this natural area.
- 2. I am coming to the Camp Out; do I need to purchase tickets to the Campfire Jamboree Concert on Friday Night?**
No, Campfire Jamboree entrance is included in your Family Campout ticket purchase.
- 3. Do I have to stay for the entire event?**
No, but we encourage families to spend the night. Volunteers will only be available to help move gear in and out of the meadow at the beginning and end of the event.
- 4. Can I bring my less than 4 year-old child?**
Yes, however, we feel that the activities that we have planned are best suited for children 4 and older.
- 5. Can we bring in snacks?**
Yes
- 6. What food will we be served?**
*Dinner - Friday, September 22 – Food Available for purchase at camper's expense.
Breakfast – Saturday, September 23 – Food available for purchase at camper's expense
Lunch – Saturday, September 23 - Boxed lunch included with ticket purchase
Dinner- Saturday, September 23 – Dinner and s'mores included with ticket purchase
Breakfast – Sunday, September 24 – Food available for purchase at camper's expense*

Throughout the event we will provide snacks (apples, granola bars) and drinks (water, lemonade).
- 7. I don't eat meat or I have a dietary restriction, should I bring my own food.**
We will provide non-meat options. They will not be vegan options, however. If you have other special needs please let us know and we will see what assistance we can provide.
- 8. Can we bring dogs or other pets?**
No
- 9. Will you set up equipment for us?**
*We will have staff on hand to **HELP** you set up. You'll need to have all the equipment you need to set up and know how to do it.*
- 10. May I build a campfire?**
We will have campfires built by Allerton staff only. No individual fires are allowed.
- 11. What sorts of facilities are provided?**
*The Allerton Visitor's Center will be open throughout the event; additionally, we will have portable sinks, and portable toilets. **No** showers.*
- 12. If I can't accompany my child on a hike, or they are too young for an activity, can someone else watch them for me?**
*We **will not** be providing for child care during this event.*
